Tip of the Month

When buying AMMO at a discount store, check to see that the DRAM Rating is 2 3/4 Dram. The THREE DRAM load is just too heavy to use for normal games here at the club. It will hurt your shoulder or kick the stock into your face. This will result in you being recoil sensitive and cause you to lift your head in anticipation of the recoil. The next thing you hear will be lost target!

FEEL THE RECOIL FOLKS! If the gun doesn't feel right or sound right when fired, check the barrel! A WAD may be stuck in the barrel and we don't want to put a live round behind it. If the wad is not cleared and the gun is fired it may BLOW the barrel and guess who is holding the gun!

Lunch is included in the price of the shoot. Cash prizes will be paid to High Over All, Runner Up and 1st Place in each Class and/or Concurrent. 2nd place in each class or concurrent will win 25 targets from the club, good for Sporting Clays or Five Stand.

Registration begins at 7:45 a.m. Warm up begins at 9:00 a.m. and tournament shooting begins at 9:00 a.m.

Sunday, July 25th - Knight's Trail Sub-Gauge Challenge - Fun Shoot. Sporting Clays, All Gauges Welcome Fun Shoot - 100 Bird Non Registered Shoot - \$40.00 registration fee, includes tax and lunch. Registration at 8:30 am, shooting starts at 9:00am and scores turned in no later than 12:30 pm. Handicap system will be used for the gauges. 12 ga. = scratch, 16 ga. = +3 targets, 20 ga. = +5 targets, 28 ga. = +10 targets, .410 bore = +20 targets and side by side or pump regardless of gauge = +5 targets.
